

MONTHLY hate crime REPORT

APRIL 2024

Criminal offences motivated by intolerance or by prejudice against a particular group in the society have been termed “hate crimes”. Two requirements need to be met to qualify this form of crime: the offence must be provided for in the criminal law, and its commission must have been motivated by prejudice. The Helsinki Committee for Human Rights has undertaken to register and map these hate crimes, and this monthly report provides an overview of the incidents registered within the specified period.

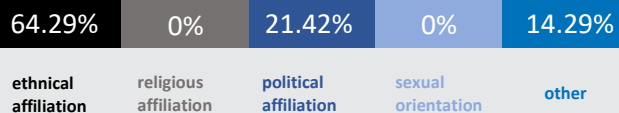

On 25.04.2024 at 14:00 hrs, G.G. (45) from the village of Dedino, Municipality of Konče, reported to the Radoviš Police Station that, on the night between 24th and 25th of April 2024, between 22:00 and 06:00 hrs, the glass pane on a structure in the village of Dedino was broken, which was used as the headquarters for a country's presidential candidate.
