Hate Crime MONTHLY



Criminal acts motivated by intolerance, that is, prejudices against a certain group in society, are described as hate crimes. Two conditions must be met for the existence of these hate crimes: the act must be foreseen in the criminal law and the act must be motivated by some type of prejudice. The Helsinki Committee for Human Rights registers and maps hate crimes, and this Monthly provides an overview of registered incidents for the specific period.


